1. Entries shall be mailed or delivered to:

no later than 12 noon Thursday on February 27, 2020

2. Payment must accompany the entry form (no exceptions):

\$150 for each entry of a Breeding Bull born in 2018, **\$125** for each entry of an Open Heifer Born in 2018, **\$125** for each entry of a Bred Heifer Born in 2017, **\$75** for each entry of a Bull Calf Born in 2019, and **\$100** for each entry of a **Pen of Two** Heifer Calves born in 2019.

Payment may be made by cash, cheque, MasterCard or Visa.

The full entry fee will be refunded if your entry is not accepted.

The entry fee will be forfeited if entry is accepted and the Bison are not presented for the Show & Sale.

All Bison entered will be sold unreserved to the highest bidder.

All Bison will be sold by the **head**, not by the pound.

- 3. There will be **five** classes:
 - A. Semen Tested Breeding Bulls born in 2018
 - B. Confirmed Open Heifers born in 2018
 - C. Bred Heifers Born in 2017
 - D. Bull Calves born in 2019 (can be penned with 1 or more bull calves as requested by, and entered by, the owner, but will be judged & sold individually)
 - E. **Pen of Two** Heifer Calves born in 2019 (will be judged & sold by **Pen of 2**)

A maximum of 20 entries (**Pen of 2** Heifer Calves is <u>one entry</u>) will be accepted in each class, unless other classes are under subscribed.

- 2018 Breeding Bulls must have a satisfactory Breeding evaluation report from a DVM.
- 2018 Open Heifers are to be confirmed Open by Consignor and will not be pregnancy tested.
- 4. Each Consignor will be limited to a maximum of **three** entries of singles in Classes A, B, C, and D or **three Pens of Two** for the Heifer Calves in Class E as submitted by **February 21**, then two additional entries if the class is not full.

- 5. Consignors must be paid up members of the Canadian Bison Association and its Regional Associations across Canada, or any member of the National Bison Association in the USA.
- 6. In the event there are more entries in a class than the limit (and all other classes are full), the Committee may reduce the class by draw, starting with Consignors that entered five animals, until the limit is reached.
- 7. In the event there are fewer animals entered in a class, the Committee will first solicit additional animals from Consignors who entered animals in that class, then from all Consignors who entered animals in any class, and finally from members who have not entered any animals in any class.
- 8. Consignors will be expected to enter quality animals **that meet the minimum weight requirements as listed on the Entry Form**. These animals will be advertised as the best each consignor has for sale at the time of the Wildrose, therefore it will be in the Consignor's best interest to enter only good quality animals.
- 9. The sale committee reserves the right to withdraw any animal from the Show and Sale that is bleeding, injured or appears to be unhealthy. Consignors of injured animals will take them home. Bison may be horned or dehorned, but dehorning must be healed.
- 10. Consigned bison will require one numbered Wildrose Dangle Tag (which will be sent out by the office of the BPA once your Entry is received), plus have a CCIA RFID button-type Tag. A numbered Wildrose Tag will be attached to any consigned bison that arrives at VJV without one, at a cost to the consignor. Vet Inspection and age verification may be done upon arrival.

 Consignor will be charged \$50 per animal for EACH incorrectly tagged bison brought in.
- 11. The <u>sales commission</u> is **8** % on every animal entered in the Sale (which includes 5% commission to VJV on every animal), and all animals will be sold on a "no reserve" basis. There will be three BPA Barn Crew people that will be on site at the CRE Pavilion to ensure the best care for your bison.
- 12. **Bison must arrive on WEDNESDAY, March 11th** between **1 PM** and **6 PM**. Vold Jones Vold will provide insurance coverage on the Bison for the period from unloading on WEDNESDAY to load-out on Friday. All Bison MUST be loaded out Friday by 4 PM.
- 13. The Wildrose Show and Sale Committee, and or their Agents or employees, assumes no liability for damages or losses to any Bison entered in the Show, or the damages or losses to third parties caused by any Bison entered in the show, or of any discrepancy between buyer and seller.
- 14. In the event of any disputes arising from the show and sale, the decision of Wildrose Show and Sale Committee shall be final.
